- You will receive vacation days (no charge) equivalent to one week of
 scheduled service. If you have used up all of your vacation, you will then pay your regular rate. Your first
 days missed will be counted as your vacation even if you have a scheduled vacation in July or August.
- If parents are splitting accounts, vacation days will be split between the two individuals. For example, if your child comes 5 days a week, each parent will have 2.5 days of vacation to use. If your child comes 3 days a week, each parent will have 1.5 days of vacation to use.
- All rates include swimming fees and most field trips. However, there will be one major field trip in each
 month that will require an additional fee (usually around \$15 per child). If we feel the group is young we
 will follow this schedule: None in June, one in July and two in August
- There is a required deposit equal to one week of care. To avoid this fee, sign up for automatic withdrawal. This deposit must be paid at the time of registration and will be held as payment for your final week of camp. Billing statements will be sent via email every week, reflecting charges that you have incurred in the last 5 days. Billing statements will reflect the services that have been used; therefore, it is imperative that you stay current with your account to avoid disruptions of services.

Grace Lutheran Foundation also offers an automatic payment plan. (ACH)

If you decide to take advantage of this service, funds will automatically be withdrawn from your bank account. The dates for these will be sent in the welcome packet, because at print time we are unsure how many snow days will need to be made up. The amount withdrawn will be on your most recent statement. To sign up the Automatic Payment Request Form must be completed before the first payment is due. Also

no deposit is required if utilizing the ACH payment plan.

MyWIChildcare EBT Card families are welcome.

Schedule

If your schedule varies, we must be notified every Wednesday morning of your child's schedule for the following week. Failure to turn in schedule by deadline will result in a charge and may limit what we have available for space.



Enrollment Information

If your child is currently enrolled in our school-age childcare program, we do not need new enrollment information for the summer. However, you do need to fill out the attached two registration forms. If you are not currently using our services, we will send you an enrollment packet. These forms must be completed and returned to us before your child can attend the summer camp program.

Lunch/Snack

Sunsational Summer Camp will provide a healthy morning and afternoon snack.
